

Chicken



Habitat: Domestic chickens use farms and backyards as their habitat

Size: They can range in size from 1.1 pounds to over 11 pounds.

Life Span: 5-10 years

Diet: grains, seeds, insects, invertebrates, fruits

Reproduction: Fertilized eggs hatch after 21 days incubation. Chicks use their beaks and sharp egg tooth (a bump on the tip of the beak) to break out of the shell.
