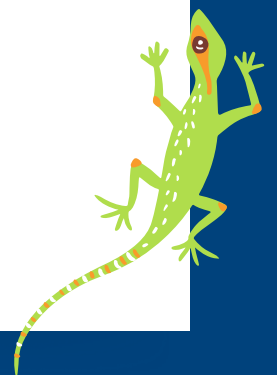
School/Group Advanced Tickets

- **School Field Trip Form**

 - Licensed Pre-K-12 schools and colleges
 - During the months of September-June
- **Group Trip/Advanced Ticket Form**
 - Great for church groups, scouts, businesses, daycares, summer camps, etc.
 - Groups of 15 paying people or more
 - Visiting during March-November
 - Can visit on a specific date or can receive tickets for anytime during the current zoo season
- **Zoo Inclusion Ticket Form Requirements**
 - Great for organizations for clients with special needs, therapeutic organizations or group homes and special needs classrooms
 - Must purchase a minimum of 10 tickets
 - Visiting during March-November
 - Can visit on a specific date or can receive tickets good for anytime during the current zoo season

Reservations should be made at least 2 weeks in advance to receive the Advanced Ticket rates. Payment ahead of time is preferred: but not required.

Groups will have a quick and smooth entrance at the gate (Education Entrance- tiger striped door) on the day of your arrival.

Groups visiting on specific dates will receive wristbands for entry on the day of your visit.

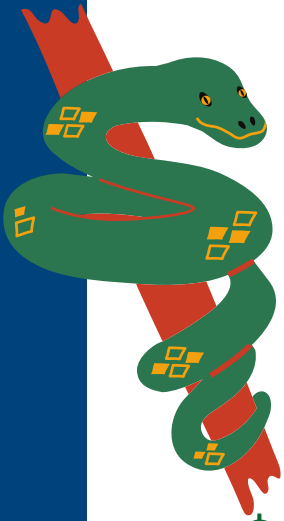
Let the Erie Zoo come to you.

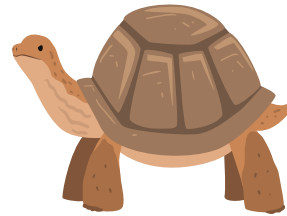
