

Please see below for FAQ's about our Traveling Zoo programs.

- How do I schedule Traveling Zoo program?
 - Please complete the Erie Traveling Zoo Request Form found on our website, or contact our Education Program Coordinator Kim Bowes at (814) 864-4091 ext. 247, email at kbowes@eriezoo.org.
 - For program fees and mileage costs, please refer to our Fee Schedule information sheet found on our website.

- What do I need to provide for the program?
 - Provide at least 1 large table (6-8ft preferred).
 - An adult/teacher must be present and in control of the audience members at all times.
 - Please refrain from having other activities happening during program setup and presentation.

- Can audience members touch the animals?
 - Ambassador animals may be touched at the discretion of zoo educators based on animal behavior and size of the audience.

- What animals will you bring?
 - We have a wide variety of species that travel for programs. While you may make animal requests, we cannot guarantee the appearance of a specific animal due a variety of external factors based on animal welfare.

- Can the Traveling Zoo present outside?
 - Yes! We can do outdoor programming – weather and temperature permitting. Please make sure the presentation area is in a shaded area.
 - If for any reason programs need to be cancelled due to weather, please call us ASAP at (814)864-4091; we will work with you to reschedule.

- When will the Traveling Zoo staff arrive for a program?
 - Our staff will arrive 15-20 minutes before a program to set up.

- Are food and drink permitted during programs?
 - No. We ask that no food or drink be consumed during programming.
