Pre-K - 2nd grade

Animal Coverings

- The students will gain a basic knowledge of what animals need to survive.
- The students will learn about animal coverings through animal visitors, biofacts and a cute story.
- 1-2 animals plus biofacts (fur, feathers, scales, spines)

2nd - 5th grade (Appropriate for all Ages)

Adaptations

- Define adaptation- superpower that helps an animal survive
- Students will look at an animal and identify what adaptations this animals has to help it survive.
- Book: "What Do You Do With a Tail Like This?"
- 1-2 animals plus biofacts (skulls, teeth, coverings)

6th-8th grade (Also Adult)

Endangered Species

- Help your students develop an awareness of the threats to animals and their habitats. Learn about some possible solutions for protecting the world's wildlife and some ways your students can help.
- Difference between threatened, endangered, least concern, etc.
- 1-2 animals plus biofacts (skulls, teeth, coverings)

Community Events

The Erie Traveling Zoo can participate in community events including fairs, festivals, fundraisers, and recognition celebrations. The Erie Traveling Zoo can attend an event for up to two hours.

These events are a booth style event where people can come up and meet 1 animal at a time.

Animal may be switched out for another species during program time and be rotated beyond that. Guests may be able to pet the allowable animals.
